### 2008 ORDINANCE 2

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 7.11 relating to: Residency Policy.

*The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do ordain as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** Section 7.11(1) of the code is amended to read:

**7.11 RESIDENCY POLICY.** (1)(AM 08-2) Employees in the following job classifications are required to establish and maintain Washington County residency within 6 months of completion of the employee's probationary period.

- (a) Administrative Coordinator
- (b) Administrator (Planning and Parks) (Samaritan Health Center)
- (c) Chief Assistant Medical Examiner
- (d) County Attorney
- (e) Director (Aging and Disability Resource Center) (Human Services De-

partment)

~~(f) Director (Department of Social Services)~~

~~(g)(f) Director/Health Officer~~

~~(h)(g) Director of Human Resources~~

~~(i)(h) Emergency Management Coordinator~~

~~(j)(i) Finance Director~~

~~(k)(j) Highway Commissioner~~

~~(l)(k) Highway Department-all employees except employees in the job classifications Accounting Assistant, Assistant to the Highway Commissioner, Project Technician/Highway and Shop Superintendent~~

~~(m)(l) Manager of Park Operations~~

~~(n)(m) Medical Examiner~~

~~(o) Program Director (CCSA)~~

~~(p)(n) Register in Probate/Probate Registrar and Clerk of Juvenile Court~~

~~(q) Sheriff's Department Employees in the following job classifications: Cook, Youth Intake Lead and Youth Aide/Intake Worker. Personnel hired under the Civil Service Ordinance currently in effect, shall be governed by the residency requirement found in that ordinance. Communications officers are required to establish residency in Washington County within 90 calendar days of their original date of appointment.~~

(o) Sheriff's Department Employees as follows:

(i) Youth Intake Lead and Youth Aide/Intake Worker shall establish and maintain Washington County residency within 6 months of completion of the employee's probationary period.

1 (ii) Employees hired under the Civil Service Ordinance currently in ef-  
2 fect shall be governed by the residency requirement found in that ordinance.

3 (iii) Washington County Corrections and Communications officers are  
4 required to establish and maintain residency in Washington County or the surrounding counties  
5 (Dodge, Fond du Lac, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Sheboygan and Waukesha) within 90 calendar days  
6 of their original date of appointment.

7 (iv) Except as otherwise allowed at the Sheriff's discretion, the Radio  
8 Systems Administrator is required to establish and maintain residency in Washington County or  
9 the surrounding counties (Dodge, Fond du Lac, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Sheboygan and Waukesha)  
10 within 6 months of their original date of appointment.

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13 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon pas-  
14 sage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.

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16 **SECTION 3. SUMMARY.** This ordinance updates the County's residency policy due  
17 to contract changes and County restructuring.
