SECTION 1. Section 4.20(1) of the code is amended to read:

PER DIEM COMPENSATION. (1)(AM 08-21) Courts. (a) Every grand and petit juror summoned upon any venire shall be paid the sum of \$25 for each day's actual a full day of attendance and \$12.50 for a half day of attendance upon any circuit court and an amount equal to the mileage rate set under §20.916(8), Wis. Stats. for each mile actually traveled each day in going and returning by the most usual route, the same being pursuant to the provisions of §756.25, Wis. Stats. In addition, judges are authorized to provide meals for jurors during the course of their duties as shall in the discretion of the judge be necessary.
