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10 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do*

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13 **SECTION 1.** Section 4.20(2) of the code is amended to read:

14 **4.20 PER DIEM COMPENSATION.** (2)(AM 08-8) **Boards and Commissions.** (a)
15 Members of Aging and Disability Resource Center Board, Civil Service Commission, County
16 Library Board, Ethics Board, and Human Services Board who are not County Board Supervisors
17 shall be paid the sum of \$35 for each day's service and mileage as provided in sec. 7.03(5) of this
18 Code for each mile traveled in the discharge of their duties.

29 the discharge of their duties, subject to the availability of State or Federal funding.

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31 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon pas-
32 sage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.

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34 **SECTION 3. SUMMARY.** This ordinance amendment adds citizen members of the
35 Aging and Disability Resource Center Board to the list for per diem compensation.
