8 **Endorsement of the Regional Water Quality Management**
9 **Plan Update for the Greater Milwaukee Watersheds**

11 **WHEREAS**, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, which was
12 duly created by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin in accordance with Section 66.0309(2) of
13 the Wisconsin Statutes on the 8th day of August 1960, upon petition of the Counties of Kenosha,
14 Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington and Waukesha, has the function and duty
15 of making and adopting a master plan for the physical development of the region; and
16

17 **WHEREAS**, the Governor of the State of Wisconsin has designated the seven-county
18 Southeastern Wisconsin Region as an areawide water quality management planning area and the
19 Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission as the official water quality manage-
20 ment planning agency for that area, all in accordance with the procedural requirements set forth
21 in Section 208 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, pursuant to its
24 function and duty as a regional planning agency and its designation as a water quality manage-
25 ment planning agency, has prepared and adopted at its meeting held on the 5th day of December,
26 2007, an update to the areawide water quality management plan set forth in a report entitled,
27 SEWRPC Planning report No. 50, *A Regional Water Quality Management Plan Update for the*
28 *Greater Milwaukee Watersheds*, published in December 2007; and

30 **WHEREAS**, the Commission has transmitted certified copies of its resolution adopting
31 the Regional Water Quality Management Plan Update for the Greater Milwaukee Watersheds,
32 together with the aforementioned SEWRPC Planning report No. 50, to the local units of govern-
33 ment concerned and to the appropriate state and federal agencies; and

35 **WHEREAS**, Washington County has supported, participated in the financing of, and
36 generally concurred in the regional planning programs undertaken by the Southeastern Wiscon-
37 sin Regional Planning Commission; and

39 **WHEREAS**, the Regional Water Quality Management Plan Update prepared by the
40 Commission is a sound and valuable guide to water quality management in the development of
41 not only the region, but also the local community, and that the endorsement of such plan by
42 Washington County will assure a common understanding by the units and agencies of govern-
43 ment concerned and enable these units and agencies of government to program the necessary
44 plan implementation work;

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of
2 Supervisors that pursuant to Section 66.0309(12) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Board hereby
3 endorses the Regional Water Quality Management Plan Update for the Greater Milwaukee Wa-
4 tersheds previously adopted by the Regional Planning Commission, as set forth in SEWRPC
5 Planning Report No. 50 as a guide for regional and community development;

7 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Washington County Clerk shall transmit a cer-
8 tified copy of this resolution to the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission and
9 to the Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
