8 AN ORDINANCE to amend Sections 5.10 and 5.18 of the code; relating to: Maintenance and  
9 Board for County Jail Prisoners; and Sheriff's Department – Fees for Services Provided.

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11 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do*  
12 *ordain as follows:*

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14 **SECTION 1.** Sections 5.10(2) and (3) of the code are amended to read:

15 **5.10 MAINTENANCE AND BOARD FOR COUNTY JAIL PRISONERS.** (2) (AM  
16 09-11) **Huber Law Prisoners.** (d) Inmates are subject to random drug screening during incar-  
17 ceration and shall be charged \$5 25 for each positive result.

18  
19 (3)(AM 09-11) **Electronic (Home) Monitoring.** Inmates placed in the home monitoring  
20 program under §302.425, Wis. Stats., shall be established at a rate of \$~~20~~ 26 per day plus an ad-  
21 ditional \$5 per day if inmate is placed on the "Mims" Program and a one-time processing fee of  
22 \$25 and shall reimburse the County for same in accordance with the law. The Sheriff may re-  
23 quire prepayment of the expenses set forth herein as a requirement for participation in this pro-  
24 gram.

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26 **SECTION 2.** Section 5.18(7) of the code is created to read:

27 **SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT – FEES FOR SERVICES PROVIDED.** ~~(7)~~(CR 09-11)  
28 **Execution of Warrant.** A charge of \$25 shall be paid for the execution of a warrant, pursuant  
29 to §§814.70(1) and 814.705(1), Wis. Stats.

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31 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective January 1,  
32 2010 and upon passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.

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34 **SECTION 4. SUMMARY.** An ordinance amendment revising certain Sheriff's De-  
35 partment fees as set pursuant to the County's annual budget cycle.
