8 AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 13.04 of the code; relating to: Speed Zones on County
9 Trunk Highways.

11 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do*
12 *ordain as follows:*

14 **SECTION 1. 13.04** of the code is amended to read:

15 **13.04 SPEED ZONES ON COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAYS.** (1)(AM 09-12) A
16 traffic and engineering investigation having been made where required on the following
17 described highways in Washington County, the maximum permissible speed at which vehicles
18 may be operated on said highways, which speed is herewith established as reasonable and safe
19 pursuant to §349.11, Wis. Stats., shall be as set forth herein, subject to approval by the State
20 Department of Transportation, Division of Highways and upon the erection of standard signs
21 giving notice thereof. All speed zones are effective in both directions of travel.

25 County Trunk Highway "FD," Town of Polk and Village of Richfield:

27 40 miles per hour from its intersection with U.S. Highway "41," easterly approx-
28 imately 2,450 feet to its intersection with U.S. Highway "45".

30 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon pas-
31 sage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.

33 **SECTION 3. SUMMARY.** An ordinance amendment recognizing the jurisdictional
34 transfer of a section of roadway to Washington County and establishing the speed limit thereon.
