5 **2009 ORDINANCE 23**

6 AN ORDINANCE to create Section 4.40 relating to: Parking Lot Regulations.

7
8 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do*
9 *ordain as follows:*

10 **SECTION 1.** Section 4.40 of the code is created to read:

11 **4.40(CR 09-23) PARKING LOT REGULATIONS.** (1)(CR 09-23) **Definitions.** For
12 the purpose of this section, the following definitions shall be used:

13 (a) **"County Campus Parking Lots."** All lands owned by Washington
14 County and designated as parking lots adjacent to county buildings located in the City of West
15 Bend including Washington County Government Center, Washington County Justice Center,
16 Washington County Public Agency Center, Washington County Vehicle Maintenance and
17 Storage Facility, Samaritan Health Center, Fields of Washington County, Youth Treatment
18 Center, Annex II, the Senior Center and Sheriff's Department.

19 (b) **"Operator."** Any person who shall operate a vehicle as the owner
20 thereof, or as the agent, employee, or permittee of the owner or is in the actual physical control
21 of a vehicle.

22 (c) **"Parking Lots."** Paved areas with signs and/or painted lines designating
23 locations for parking vehicles of employees or persons engaged in official business at the
24 County.

25 (d) **"Parking Space."** Any paved area which is duly designated for the
26 parking of a single vehicle by lines painted or otherwise marked on the paved surface of a
27 parking lot.

28 (e) **"Person."** Any individual, firm, partnership, association or corporation.

29 (f) **"Vehicle."** Any device in, upon or by which any person or property is or
30 may be transported upon a highway, except a device operated on rails or tracks.

32 (2)(CR 09-23) Parking. All vehicles shall be parked, attended or unattended, in
33 accordance with the designations placed on signs in the Parking Lots and within the designated
34 lines in the Parking Lots and in such a manner so as to not cause a hazard or be an obstruction to
35 vehicular or other traffic.

1 (3)(CR 09-23) Hours. No vehicle shall be parked, attended or unattended, in the County
2 Parking Lots between Midnight and 6:00 a.m., other than employees of the County or persons
3 engaged in official business at the County.

5 (4)(CR 09-23) Obstruction of Traffic. No person or vehicle shall obstruct the entryways,
6 exits or traffic in County Campus Parking Lots in a manner so as to prevent, interfere with or
7 obstruct the free flow and passage of other persons or vehicles within County Campus Parking
8 Lots.

10 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon
11 passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.

13 **SECTION 3. SUMMARY.** Ordinance setting forth regulations for County campus
14 parking lots.
