8 AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 7.05 of the code; relating to: Employee Benefit Program -
9 Group Health Insurance.

11 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do*
12 *ordain as follows:*

14 **SECTION 1.** 7.05(5) of the code is amended to read:

15 **7.05 EMPLOYEE BENEFIT PROGRAM.** (5)(AM 09-7) **Group Health Insurance.**

16 (b) The County shall, for each regular full-time employee, contribute an amount not to exceed
17 ~~\$472~~ \$532.60 per month toward the cost of single health insurance coverage. If such employee
18 chooses, the County will contribute an amount not to exceed ~~\$1179~~ \$1330.60 per month toward
19 the cost of dependent family coverage. Should the cost of health insurance coverage exceed
20 ~~\$1179~~ \$1330.60 per month for family coverage or ~~\$472~~ \$532.60 per month for single coverage,
21 the employee and the County shall split the cost of health insurance in excess of ~~\$1179~~ \$1330.60
22 per month for family coverage and ~~\$472~~ \$532.60 per month for single coverage on a 50/50 per-
23 centage basis.

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25 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon pas-
26 sage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.

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28 **SECTION 3. SUMMARY.** Ordinance amendment to adjust health insurance contribu-
29 tion caps.
