8 **Grant Application - 2009 Justice Assistance Stimulus Funding**
9 **American Recovery and Reinvestment Act**

11 **WHEREAS**, on February 17, 2009, President Obama signed into law the American
12 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009; and

13
14 **WHEREAS**, Wisconsin is receiving \$32.5 million in justice-related funding through
15 the Recovery Act, with \$11.2 million of these funds being awarded directly from the federal
16 government to cities and counties across the State of Wisconsin; and

18 **WHEREAS**, applicants are limited to units of local government listed in the Recovery
19 Act Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG) allocation list for JAG funds; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Washington County is listed on the Recovery Act JAG allocation list as
22 the recipient of a direct award in the amount of \$19,683.00; and

24 **WHEREAS**, there are no match requirements as part of the direct award; and

26 **WHEREAS**, Washington County may spend the awarded funds in one of seven pro-
27 gram areas, including law enforcement and technology improvement programs; and

29 **WHEREAS**, to meet the requirements of the grant, the Washington County Sheriff's
30 Department proposes to use the awarded funds to purchase law enforcement related equipment
31 and/or improved technology; and

33 **WHEREAS**, said equipment and/or technology will be purchased with the goal of im-
34 proving the productivity, efficiency and quality of service provided by the Sheriff's Depart-
35 ment to the citizens of Washington County;

37 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of
38 Supervisors that this Board approves and authorizes the Sheriff's Department to apply for and
39 accept the Recovery Act Justice Assistance Grant Program funds in the amount of \$19,683.00
40 to provide for the purchase of law enforcement related equipment and/or improved technology,
41 with the understanding that there be no additional staffing and no additional direct costs in-
42 curred by Washington County.
