8 **Grant Application – 2010 Joint DATCP/DNR Nonpoint Source**

9  
10 **WHEREAS**, Washington County Code Section 4.27 requires that grant applications be  
11 approved by the County Board of Supervisors; and

12  
13 **WHEREAS**, a Washington County Land & Water Resource Management Plan (*1<sup>st</sup> Re-*  
14 *vision 2006-2010*) was prepared under the jurisdiction of the Washington County Land Conser-  
15 vation Committee for the years 2006-2010 and was adopted by the Washington County Board of  
16 Supervisors on December 13, 2005 as 2005 Resolution 40 – Revised Washington County Land  
17 & Water Resource Management Plan; and

19 **WHEREAS**, an approved Land & Water Resource Management Plan (*1<sup>st</sup> Revision*  
20 *2006-2010*) allows the County to remain eligible for state program grant funding beginning in  
21 the year 2006 through 2010; and

23 **WHEREAS**, section §92.14, Wis. Stats., provides counties assistance with land and wa-  
24 ter conservation activities by making available allocations to counties in the form of an annual  
25 grant from an appropriation under §20.115(7)(c) or (qd) or §20.866(2)(we), Wis. Stats., to any  
26 county land conservation committee that has an approved land and water resource management  
27 plan and has undertaken county board action providing for matching funds; and

29 **WHEREAS**, Department of Natural Resources (DNR) cost sharing for targeted runoff  
30 management (TRM) projects are available under §281.65, Wis. Stats., and cost sharing and  
31 planning grants for Urban Nonpoint Source and Stormwater Management (UNPS&SW) projects  
32 are available under §281.66, Wis. Stats. for counties; and

34 **WHEREAS**, the Joint DATCP/DNR Nonpoint Source Grant Application annual dead-  
35 line is April 15 and an application for said grant has been submitted by the Planning and Parks  
36 Department, conditioned on the approval of the Washington County Board of Supervisors; and

38 **WHEREAS**, the Joint DATCP/DNR Nonpoint Source Grant program is considered a  
39 routine grant as defined under the Washington County Code 4.27(2);

41 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of Su-  
42 pervisors that the Planning and Parks Department, under the direction of the Land Conservation  
43 Committee, is authorized to apply for a Joint DATCP/DNR Nonpoint Source Grant for calendar  
44 year 2010.
