8 **Voluntary Return of County Supervisor Pay to the County**

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10 **WHEREAS**, in these times of economic uncertainty, it is prudent for Washington Coun-
11 ty to evaluate and curtail its spending in order to maximize efficiency and lessen the burden on
12 the County taxpayers; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Washington County Board of Supervisors has voted to freeze wages for
15 ordinance employees at 2009 levels for the 2010 calendar year and has asked its represented em-
16 ployees to forego a cost of living increase for 2010 as well; and

18 **WHEREAS**, county supervisors receive a nominal monthly compensation plus per diem
19 payments for attendance at meetings above a certain number per month and reimbursement for
20 expenses;

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of
23 Supervisors that any supervisor may voluntarily return, at any time, in part or in full, his or her
24 monthly salary, per diem or reimbursements and that any return of money would be considered a
25 donation to the County.
