8 **Grant Application - Alcohol Enforcement**

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10 **WHEREAS**, Washington County Code Section 4.27 requires that certain county grant
11 applications be approved by the County Board of Supervisors; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the enforcement of traffic laws remains a high priority of the general
14 public; and

15
16 **WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WI-DOT), Bureau of
17 Transportation Safety (BOTS), has made an alcohol enforcement grant available to the
18 Washington County Sheriff's Office in the amount of \$25,000 directed toward alcohol
19 enforcement in Washington County, including the purchase of up to \$5,000 towards traffic
20 enforcement equipment; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the local match requirement is met by conducting normal traffic
23 enforcement;

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of
26 Supervisors that the Washington County Sheriff's Office is authorized to apply for the DOT-
27 BOTS Alcohol Enforcement Grant in the amount of \$25,000 with a local match of \$5,000 for the
28 period of October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010 to provide additional alcohol and traffic
29 enforcement in Washington County.

31 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Washington County Sheriff's Office is hereby
32 authorized to accept the above noted grant funds with the understanding that there be no
33 additional direct costs incurred by Washington County other than those match costs stated
34 herein.

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36 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Board Chairperson and County Clerk
37 are authorized to execute the necessary application or other documents in order to obtain grant
38 funding described herein, subject to review and approval of the County Attorney's Office.
