2010 ORDINANCE 11

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 7.05 relating to: Employee Benefit Program - Vacations.

The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7.05(3) of the code is amended to read:

7.05 EMPLOYEE BENEFIT PROGRAM. (3)(AM 10-11) **Vacations.**

(d) Vacation benefits shall be administered in accordance with the following:

8. Employees with the following job titles shall be required to take at least 40 consecutive hours of paid time off each calendar year:

- a. Account Clerk
- b. Accounting Assistant
- c. Accounting Supervisor
- d. Accounting Technician
- e. Assistant to the County Treasurer
- f. Assistant Finance Director
- g. Assistant Golf Course Supervisor
- h. Assistant to the Highway Commissioner
- i. Buyer
- j. Clerk of Court Administration and Accounting Supervisor
- k. Deputy Finance Director
- l. Deputy Register of Deeds
- m. Finance Director
- n. Human Services Accounting Manager
- o. Office Supervisor (Health Department)
- p. Program Assistant (Planning & Parks position assigned to Accounting Supervisor)
- q. Purchasing Agent
- r. Purchasing Technician

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2011, upon passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 3. SUMMARY. Implementation of auditor's recommendation for positions managing department grant and other funds.
