35 **5.12 MUNICIPAL COURT PRISONERS.** (1)(AM 10-15) **Rate Established.**
36 Pursuant to §800.095(6), Wis. Stats., the daily rate for the expenses of prisoners of any municipal
37 court system within Washington County is ~~\$15~~ 20 per day.

39 **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective on January
40 1, 2011, upon passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.
