12 as follows:

14 **SECTION 1.** Section 14.01 of the code is amended to read:

15 **14.01 OFFENSES AGAINST STATE LAWS SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE.**

16 (1)(AM 10-19) **Adoption of Reference.** The following statutes following the prefix "14"
17 defining offenses against the peace and good order of the State are adopted by reference to define
18 offenses against the peace and good order of the County, provided the penalty for commission of
19 such offenses hereunder shall be limited to a forfeiture imposed under sec. 1.07 of this Code.
