8 AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 2.32 relating to: Land Information Advisory  
9 Commission.

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11 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do*  
12 *ordain as follows:*

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14 **SECTION 1.** Section 2.32 of the code is amended to read:

15 **2.32(AM 10-4) LAND INFORMATION ADVISORY COMMISSION COUNCIL.**

16 (1)(AM 10-4) The Land Information ~~Advisory Commission~~ Council shall be appointed by the  
17 ~~Planning, Conservation and Parks Committee Chairperson~~ County Board. The membership shall  
18 include ~~the~~ a member of the County Board, who is a member of the Planning, Conservation and  
19 Parks Committee, Register of Deeds, Treasurer, Real Property Lister, County Conservationist,  
20 GIS Manager/Land Information Officer, Highway Commissioner, Sheriff or designee, County  
21 Engineer/Surveyor, Assistant Administrator for Planning – Planning and Parks Department, +  
22 Planning, Conservation and Parks Committee member, a realtor or member of the Realtors  
23 Association employed within the County and may include up to 2 additional members consisting  
24 of citizens with a demonstrated interest in land information issues. The Council shall be chaired  
25 by the appointed County Board Supervisor. See §59.72, Wis. Stats.

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27 (2)(AM 10-4) Subject to the authority of the Planning, Conservation and Parks  
28 Committee, the ~~Commission~~ Council shall provide direction and policy to the County’s Land  
29 Information Office, coordinate land information projects within the County, promote the benefits  
30 and uses of the land information program, approve revisions to the Countywide plan for land  
31 records modernization and integration, previously adopted, and provide input on the Land  
32 Information Office’s recommendations regarding local governmental unit project grant  
33 applications to the state Land Information Board.

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35 (3)(AM 10-4) Meetings shall be held quarterly or more often as needed.

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37 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon  
38 passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.

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40 **SECTION 3. SUMMARY.** Ordinance amendment to adjust membership of the Land  
41 Information Advisory Commission and to rename the body to comply with state law.
