9 **Grant Application – FFY 2009 –**
10 **Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program**

11 **WHEREAS**, Washington County Code Section 4.27 requires that all county grant
12 applications be approved by the County Board of Supervisors; and

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14 **WHEREAS**, the State of Wisconsin, Office of Justice Assistance (OJA) has available
15 funds from the federal government for Federal Fiscal Year 2009 within the UASI Program to be
16 provided to fund regional initiatives in Washington County for domestic preparedness equipment
17 and other preparedness efforts; and

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19 **WHEREAS**, no jurisdiction is exempt from the possibility of incidents of terrorism; and

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21 **WHEREAS**, there are numerous devices that have the capability to cause death, or
22 serious injury, through the release of toxic or poisonous chemicals, disease organisms or
23 explosives or by other means; and

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25 **WHEREAS**, the residents of Washington County would benefit from having the
26 appropriate domestic preparedness training, programming and equipment to prepare for, respond
27 to and recover from acts of terrorism; and

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29 **WHEREAS**, grant funds of up to \$299,000.00 may be available for the UASI Grant
30 Program through the Office of Justice Assistance to the Washington County Office of
31 Emergency Management to acquire appropriate equipment, programming and/or training in
32 order to address preparedness for and response to acts of and consequences of terrorism;

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34 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of
35 Supervisors that the Emergency Management Coordinator is authorized to apply for a grant as
36 stated above;

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38 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Administration Department – Office of
39 Emergency Management is hereby authorized to accept the above noted grant funds with the
40 understanding that there be no additional direct costs incurred by Washington County other than
41 those costs to be covered by the grant award.

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43 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that upon receipt of grant funds, distribution will be at
44 the discretion of the Washington County Emergency Management Coordinator and Public Safety
45 Committee, consistent with the requirements of the grant.
