6 AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 4.20 relating to: Per Diem Compensation.

8 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do*
9 *ordain as follows:*

10 **SECTION 1.** Section 4.20(4) of the code is amended to read:

11 **4.20 PER DIEM COMPENSATION.** (4)(AM 11-5) **County Board**
12 **Compensation.** (a) County Board Supervisors shall receive a salary, pursuant to §59.10(1)(c),
13 Wis. Stats., of ~~\$550~~ \$450 per month and the County Board Chairperson shall receive a salary of
14 \$2,985 per month. Said compensation shall be calculated on a daily basis and shall begin with
15 the first calendar day of the board member's term of office and shall run continuously up to and
16 including the board member's last calendar day in office.
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20 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon
21 passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.
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23 **SECTION 3. SUMMARY.** Ordinance amendment to reduce monthly salary of County
24 Board Supervisors for the 2012-2014 term, commencing April 2012.
