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8 **Grant Application – 2011 Notice of Discharge/Intent (NOD/NOI) Project Funding**

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10 **WHEREAS**, Washington County Code Section 4.27 requires that grant applications be  
11 approved by the County Board of Supervisors or subsequent review and ratification; and

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13 **WHEREAS**, Washington County has received correspondence from the Wisconsin  
14 Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) regarding a Notice of Intent to Issue a Notice of  
15 Discharge for Wastewater Discharge due to an occurrence of animal waste discharge determined  
16 as a Category III unacceptable practice as found under §NR243.24(1)(c), Wisconsin  
17 Administrative Code; and

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19 **WHEREAS**, a WDNR site investigation and complaint warranted that the discharge is  
20 known or strongly suspected of causing fecal contamination of a water supply well; and

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22 **WHEREAS**, Washington County desires to receive grant funding from the Department  
23 of Natural Resources (WDNR), Bureau of Watershed Management and the Wisconsin  
24 Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP), Bureau of Land and  
25 Water Resources for grant assistance consistent with and under the authority of §92.14, Wis.  
26 Stats., Chapter ATCP 50, Wis. Adm. Code and the authority of §281.65(4e), Wis. Stats., and  
27 Chapters NR 153 and 154, Wis. Adm. Code; regarding a Notice of Discharge/Intent (NOD/NOI)  
28 Project Funding for the purposes of implementing measures to assist in reducing and/or  
29 eliminating the nonpoint source wastewater pollution discharge; and

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31 **WHEREAS**, the County may apply for a cost share grant (deadline application of June  
32 10, 2011) from the DNR and/or DATCP to resolve the requirements of a NOI or NOD issued by  
33 WDNR pursuant to §NR 243.24(3), Wis. Adm. Code; and

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35 **WHEREAS**, Washington County agrees to contribute a local share (also called “match”)  
36 by means of staff assistance for meeting the professional technical/engineering design and  
37 installation requirements for best management practices needed for the project; and

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39 **WHEREAS**, Washington County understands that funding eligibility requires a project  
40 to meet the grant award criteria and the grantee management requirements of the state agency  
41 providing the grant funds;

43 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of  
44 Supervisors that the Planning and Parks Department, Land and Water Conservation Division,  
45 under the direction of the Land Conservation Committee, authorizes the Planning and Parks  
46 Department Administrator to apply and submit a signed DNR and DATCP Cost Share Grant  
47 Application for a Notice of Discharge/Intent (NOD/NOI) Project Funding in the amount of  
48 \$226,625.00.
