8 AN ORDINANCE to amend Sections 7.11 of the Code relating to: Residency Policy.

10 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do ordain*
11 *as follows:*

13 **SECTION 1.** Section 7.11(1) of the code is amended to read:

14 **7.11 RESIDENCY POLICY.** (1)(AM 11-20) Employees in the following job
15 classifications are required to establish and maintain Washington County residency within 6
16 months of completion of the employee’s introductory period.

20 (l) Highway Department-all employees except employees in the job classifi-
21 cations Accounting Assistant, Assistant to the Highway Commissioner, Project Techni-
22 cian/Highway, ~~and Shop Superintendent and Transit Manager.~~

26 (p) Sheriff’s Department Employees as follows:

27 (i) Juvenile Detention Administrator shall establish and maintain
28 Washington County residency within 6 months of completion of the employee's introductory
29 period.

30 (ii) Employees hired under the Civil Service Ordinance currently in
31 effect shall be governed by the residency requirement found in that ordinance.

32 (iii) Washington County Corrections and Communications ~~Officers~~
33 are required to establish and maintain residency in Washington County or the surrounding
34 counties (Dodge, Fond du Lac, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Sheboygan and Waukesha) ~~within 90~~
35 ~~calendar days of their original date of appointment~~ by the end of the introductory period.

37 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon
38 passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.

40 **SECTION 3. SUMMARY.** Ordinance amendment updating residency for certain
41 Highway and Sheriff Department Personnel.
