8 **Grant Application - Alcohol Enforcement**

10 **WHEREAS**, Washington County Code Section 4.27 requires that certain county grant
11 applications be approved by the County Board of Supervisors; and

12
13 **WHEREAS**, the enforcement of traffic laws remains a high priority of the general
14 public; and

15
16 **WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WI-DOT), Bureau of
17 Transportation Safety (BOTS), has made an alcohol enforcement grant available to the
18 Washington County Sheriff's Department in the amount of \$30,000 directed toward alcohol
19 enforcement in Washington County; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the grant period for the grant allocation is from October 1, 2011 through
22 September 30, 2012 and permits the purchase of up to \$5,000 towards traffic enforcement
23 equipment; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the local match requirement of \$7,500 is met by conducting normal traffic
26 enforcement; and

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of
29 Supervisors that the Washington County Sheriff's Department is authorized to apply for the
30 DOT-BOTS Alcohol Enforcement Grant in the amount of \$30,000 with a local match of \$7,500
31 for the period of October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012 to provide additional alcohol and
32 traffic enforcement in Washington County;

34 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Washington County Sheriff's Department is
35 hereby authorized to accept the above noted grant funds with the understanding that there be no
36 additional direct costs incurred by Washington County other than those match costs stated
37 herein.

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39 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Board Chairperson and County Clerk
40 are authorized to execute the necessary application or other documents in order to obtain grant
41 funding described herein, subject to review and approval of the County Attorney's Office.
