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8 **Grant Application – Treatment Alternatives and Diversion (TAD) Program**

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10 **WHEREAS**, Washington County Code Section 4.27 requires that all county grant  
11 applications be approved by the County Board of Supervisors; and

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13 **WHEREAS**, Washington County Code Section 4.27(4) also states that a department  
14 head may make application subject to later County Board approval for grant funds if the exter-  
15 nally imposed grant deadline requires application prior to the next scheduled County Board  
16 meeting; and

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18 **WHEREAS**, the TAD program is intended to reduce recidivism, increase public safety  
19 and reduce the jail population; and

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21 **WHEREAS**, since the start of the TAD program in 2007, 424 clients have been served  
22 specifically for 2<sup>nd</sup> OWI cases and referrals for Department of Corrections (“DOC”) clients in  
23 need of services; and

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25 **WHEREAS**, of the 424 clients to date, 23 are currently active in the program, 293 have  
26 successfully completed the program and 108 were terminated from the program for non  
27 compliance; and

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29 **WHEREAS**, Genesis Behavioral Services, Inc (treatment provider for the program)  
30 reports the overall completion rate of the program is 73%; and

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32 **WHEREAS**, Washington County was originally advised the grant offered would be  
33 \$84,371 with a \$27,790 match, which was budgeted for; and

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35 **WHEREAS**, Washington County has been advised they will be offered a revised grant  
36 funding of \$92,635 with a \$30,878 match requirement for the 2012 calendar year for the program  
37 with continued contractual services of Genesis Behavioral to serve OWI referrals from the  
38 District Attorney’s office and probation clients from the DOC office in West Bend, with  
39 Washington County residency; and

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41 **WHEREAS**, \$27,790 was budgeted for the match, and \$3,088 from the Electronic  
42 Monitoring expense account will be applied to achieve the total match required of \$30,878; and

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44 **WHEREAS**, the Public Safety Committee approved the grant application with revised  
45 grant funding and revised match amounts; and

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47 **WHEREAS**, Washington County is one of the seven counties eligible for this grant; and
