8 **Reauthorization of Self-Insurance for Worker's Compensation Liabilities**

9  
10 **WHEREAS**, Washington County is a qualified political subdivision of the State of  
11 Wisconsin; and

12  
13 **WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act (Act) provides that employers  
14 covered by the Act either insure their liability with worker's compensation insurance carriers  
15 authorized to do business in the State of Wisconsin or assume the responsibility for its own  
16 worker's compensation risk and payment by self-insurance; and

17  
18 **WHEREAS**, the State and its political subdivisions may self-insure worker's  
19 compensation without a special order from the Department of Workforce Development  
20 (Department) upon a commitment to report faithfully all compensible injuries and to comply  
21 with the Act and rules of the Department; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the Administrative Services Committee at its February 16, 2012, meeting  
24 approved the continuation of the self-insured worker's compensation program, in compliance  
25 with Wisconsin Administrative Code DWD §80.60(3);

26  
27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of  
28 Supervisors that Washington County shall faithfully report all compensable work related injuries  
29 to the State of Wisconsin and comply with the Workers Compensation Act and the Department's  
30 rules.

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32 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County shall continue its self-insured worker's  
33 compensation program that is currently in effect.

35 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Clerk shall forward a certified copy of  
36 this Resolution to the Worker's Compensation Division, Wisconsin Department of Workforce  
37 Development.
