5 **2012 ORDINANCE 3**

6 AN ORDINANCE to create Section 4.11 relating to: Highway Commissioner.

8 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do ordain*
9 *as follows:*

10 **SECTION 1.** Section 4.11 of the code is created to read:

11 **4.11(CR 12-3) HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER.** (1)(CR 12-3) **Creation.** Pursuant to
12 §83.01, Wis. Stats., there is hereby created the position of Highway Commissioner as a full-time
13 position.

14 (2)(CR 12-3) **Term.** The Highway Commissioner shall be elected by the County Board
15 upon the recommendation of the Transportation Committee for a 4 year term.

16 (3)(CR 12-3) **Duties.** The duties of the Highway Commissioner shall be generally as set
17 forth in Chapter 83 of the Wisconsin Statutes. Specific duties of the Highway Commissioner
18 shall be as approved by the Administrative Services Committee in the detailed class specification
19 for the position.

20 (4)(CR 12-3) **Salary.** The salary of the Highway Commissioner shall be as set by the
21 Board pursuant to §83.01(6), Wis. Stats., to be determined by the Administrative Services
22 Committee and shall, together with other employee benefits, be payable as other County
23 employees.

24 (5)(CR 12-3) **Bond.** The Highway Commissioner shall file an official bond as required
25 by sec. 4.21 of this Code.

26 (6)(CR 12-3) **Supervising Committee.** The Transportation Committee shall have
27 jurisdiction over the activities and functions of the Highway Commissioner.

28 **SECTION 2. Sections ~~4.11~~ 4.12 through 4.16 Reserved**

29 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon
30 passage by the Board of Supervisors, publication as provided by law, with implementation as of
31 the January, 2013 term.

32 **SECTION 4. SUMMARY.** Ordinance recognizing the Highway Commissioner
33 position in the Code and setting a 4 year term commencing January, 2013.
