24 incorporate the changes proposed in this ordinance.

26 **SECTION 3. 7.11 RESIDENCY POLICY.** (1)(AM 13-1) Employees in the following
27 job classifications are required to establish and maintain Washington County residency within 6
28 months of completion of the employee’s introductory period.

30 (p) Sheriff’s Department Employees as follows:

31 (i) Juvenile Detention Administrator ~~Administrator~~ Manager is required to establish
32 and maintain residency in Washington County or the surrounding counties (Dodge, Fond du Lac,
33 Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Sheboygan and Waukesha) by the end of the introductory period. ~~shall~~
