13 **SECTION 1.** Section 4.20(4) of the code is amended to read:

14 **4.20 PER DIEM COMPENSATION.** (4)(AM 13-14) **County Board**
15 **Compensation.**

18 (c) County Board Supervisors, other than the County Board Chairperson, shall
19 be paid, pursuant to §59.10(1)(c), Wis. Stats., a per diem for each full day of meetings attended
20 in excess of ~~30~~ 40 meetings. Per diem eligibility will commence on the first day after the day in
21 which the ~~thirtieth~~ fortieth meeting is attended. Said per diem payment shall be accrued in
22 accordance with the following schedule:
