### 2013 ORDINANCE 17

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 21.09 of the code; relating to: Comprehensive Plan - Amendment No. 1 of *A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035*.

*The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do* ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The County Board, by the enactment of an ordinance, formally adopted the document titled *A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035* as the County comprehensive plan on April 15, 2008.

**SECTION 2.** Washington County has duly noticed a public hearing on the comprehensive plan amendment known as Amendment No. 1 of *A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035* and the Planning, Conservation and Parks Committee held the public hearing on October 16, 2013 in accordance with Section 66.1001(4)(d) of the *Statutes*.

**SECTION 3.** The Planning, Conservation and Parks Committee, by a majority vote of the entire Committee at a meeting held on October 18, 2013 recommended to the County Board the adoption of an amendment known as Amendment No. 1 of *A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035*.

**SECTION 4.** The Washington County Board of Supervisors has adopted 2013 Resolution 40, approving Amendment No. 1 of *A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035*.

**SECTION 5.** 21.09 of the Code is amended to read:

**21.09 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.** (AM 13-17) Washington County Board of Supervisors formally adopts the document entitled "SEWRPC Community Assistance Planning Report No. 287, *A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035*," including the following amendment as its Comprehensive Plan for Washington County consistent with and addressing the requirements of §66.1001, Wis. Stats.

- Amendment No. 1 of *A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035*

**SECTION 6.** The County Clerk is directed to send a copy of this ordinance and the plan amendment to the parties listed in Section 66.1001(4)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.
