8 AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 21.09 of the code; relating to: Comprehensive Plan -  
9 Amendment No. 2 of *A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington*  
10 *County: 2035*.

11  
12 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do* ordain as  
13 follows:

14  
15 **SECTION 1.** The Planning, Conservation and Parks Committee, by a majority vote of  
16 the entire Committee at a meeting held on September 30, 2013, recommended the adoption of  
17 the County’s Farmland Preservation Plan as required by Chapter 91 of the Wisconsin Statutes.  
18 The County’s Farmland Preservation Plan will be made a part of the Comprehensive Plan by  
19 adoption of an amendment known as Amendment No. 2: Appendix T – A Farmland Preservation  
20 Plan for Washington County to *A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington*  
21 *County: 2035*.

23 **SECTION 2.** Section 21.09 of the Code is amended to read:

24 **21.09 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.** (AM 13-18) Washington County Board of  
25 Supervisors formally adopts the document entitled "SEWRPC Community Assistance Planning  
26 Report No. 287, *A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035*,"  
27 including the following amendments as its Comprehensive Plan for Washington County  
28 consistent with and addressing the requirements of §66.1001, Wis. Stats.

35 **SECTION 3.** The County Clerk is directed to send a copy of this ordinance and the plan  
36 amendment to the parties listed in Section 66.1001(4)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

38 **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon  
39 passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.

41 **SECTION 5. SUMMARY.** Ordinance amendment to incorporate Comprehensive Plan  
42 Amendment No. 2 into the text of the Washington County Code.
