8 AN ORDINANCE to amend Sections 5.10 and 5.18 relating to: Maintenance and Board for
9 County Jail Prisoners and Sheriff’s Department – Fees for Services Provided.

11 *The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do ordain*
12 *as follows:*

14 **SECTION 1.** Sections 5.10(2) and (3) of the code are amended to read:

15 **5.10 MAINTENANCE AND BOARD FOR COUNTY JAIL PRISONERS. * * ***

17 (2)(CR 13-23) **Convicted Prisoners.** (a) Every prisoner who is sentenced to the
18 Washington County Jail serving straight time shall pay a one-time processing fee (Booking Fee)
19 of \$30 and shall reimburse the County for the same in accordance with the law.

21 (b) Every prisoner sentenced to Wisconsin Department of Corrections
22 probation who is placed on Hold Status in the Washington County Jail, shall pay a one-time
23 processing fee (Booking Fee) of \$30 and shall reimburse the County for the same in accordance
24 with the law.

26 (c) Every prisoner requesting a transfer to or from the Washington County Jail
27 shall be charged a fee of \$50 per request to cover the administrative costs of background
28 investigation and coordination of transfer and shall reimburse the County for same in accordance
29 with the law.

31 (~~2~~ 3) (AM 13-23) **Huber Law Prisoners.** (a) Every prisoner who is sentenced to the
32 Washington County Jail under the provisions of §303.08(4), Wis. Stats., (Huber Law) and is
33 gainfully employed, shall be liable to Washington County for per capita maintenance and board
34 costs at the rate of \$20 per day and a one-time processing fee of \$~~25~~ 30 and shall reimburse the
35 County for the same in accordance with the law.

37 (b) Inmates granted release for purposes of conducting the self-employed
38 occupation of housekeeping or attending the needs of a person's family shall be established at the
39 rate of \$20 per day and a one-time processing fee of \$~~25~~ 30 and shall reimburse the County for
40 the same in accordance with the law.

42 (c) Inmates granted release to pursue educational studies, other than required
43 high school attendance, shall be established at the rate of \$20 per day and a one-time processing
44 fee of \$~~25~~ 30 and shall reimburse the County for the same in accordance with the law.

5.18 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT – FEES FOR SERVICES PROVIDED. (7)(AM 13-23) **Execution of Warrant.** A charge of \$25 30 shall be paid for the execution of a warrant, pursuant to §§814.70(1) and 814.705(1), Wis. Stats.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.
