An introductory employee may be discharged for any 22 reason without recourse and without cause. Introductory periods may be extended for a period 23 not to exceed an additional 6 months, subject to prior approval by the Administrative Services 24 Committee, and the departmental liaison committee. A newly hired County Manager, 25 Corrections and Communications Officers, and Civil Service personnel in the Sheriff's 26 Department shall serve an initial 12-month introductory period. Introductory periods may be 27 extended for a period not to exceed an additional 6 months, subject to prior approval by the 28 Human Resources Director, or designee, and the Department Head. Satisfactory completion of 29 introductory period is not a guarantee of continued employment. 30 31 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective upon 32 passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law. 33 34 **SECTION 3.
