13 *as follows:*

15 **SECTION 1.** Section 7.02 of the Code is amended to read:

16 **7.02 WASHINGTON COUNTY STAFFING PLAN.** (AM 13-9)

23 (20) The position is eligible to share in golf lesson revenue at 80% of golf lesson fees
24 collected. Employee shall have passed the Professional Golf Association (PGA) Players
25 Ability Test and related requirements in order to be eligible to share in revenue. See
26 Washington County Golf Course Lesson Policy and Procedure.

28 **SECTION 2.** The list of pay grades established in Section 7.03(1)(a) shall be adjusted to
29 incorporate the changes proposed in this ordinance.

31 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective upon
32 passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.
