8 **Adoption of Amendment No. 1 – Land Use Map and Related Text**
9 **of A *Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035***

11 **WHEREAS**, the Washington County Board of Supervisors adopted A *Multi-*
12 *Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035* as the County comprehensive
13 plan on April 15, 2008, following extensive public participation; and

14
15 **WHEREAS**, the Planning, Conservation, and Parks Committee finds that the
16 comprehensive plan, with Amendment No. 1, contains all of the required elements specified in
17 Section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes and that the comprehensive plan, with the proposed
18 amendment, is internally consistent; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the County has duly noticed and held a public hearing on the proposed
21 amendment, following the procedures in Section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes and the
22 public participation procedures for comprehensive plan amendments adopted by the County
23 Board on January 12, 2010; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the County Board adopted the County comprehensive plan before all of the
26 cities, towns and villages within the County had adopted their local comprehensive plans and it
27 was acknowledged at such time that the County comprehensive plan would be amended
28 following adoption of all the local plans to incorporate the local plans into the County
29 comprehensive plan; and

31 **WHEREAS**, Washington County, in cooperation with the Southeastern Wisconsin
32 Regional Planning Commission, requested all comprehensive plan amendments adopted by all
33 local governments in the County which was used to create an updated land use map and related
34 text, tables and figures for Chapter IX – Land Use Element of A *Multi-Jurisdictional Plan for*
35 *Washington County: 2035*; and

37 **WHEREAS**, Amendment No. 1 was used as the basis for the development of the
38 Farmland Preservation Plan for Washington County; and

40 **WHEREAS**, copies of Amendment No. 1 were available for public review in the
41 Washington County Planning and Parks Department office, at public libraries, and on the County
42 website; and

44 **WHEREAS**, the County duly noticed a public hearing on Amendment No. 1 of A *Multi-*
45 *Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035* and the Planning,
46 Conservation, and Parks Committee held the public hearing on October 16, 2013 in accordance
47 with Section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes and the public participation procedures for
48 comprehensive plan amendments adopted by the County Board on January 12, 2010; and
