8 **Grant Application – Wisconsin Emergency Management**
9 **Criminal Acts or Acts of Terrorism Exercise**

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11 **WHEREAS**, Washington County Code Section 4.27 requires that all county grant
12 programs or applications for funds receive prior approval by the County Board of Supervisors;
13 and

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15 **WHEREAS**, Wisconsin Emergency Management (WEM) has available funds from the
16 Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to be provided to counties to address local exercise
17 needs such as testing existing plans and procedures through exercise scenarios by simulating
18 emergency conditions or events; and

20 **WHEREAS**, no jurisdiction is exempt from the unlawful use of force or violence by a
21 group or individual; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the residents of Washington County would benefit from having exercises
24 conducted to prepare for, respond to and recover from criminal acts or acts of terrorism; and

26 **WHEREAS**, grant funds of \$19,250 are available for an exercise program from WEM to
27 test appropriate plans, procedures, personnel and equipment needed to address acts of and
28 consequences resulting from criminal acts or acts of terrorism;

30 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Washington County Board of
31 Supervisors that the Emergency Management Coordinator is authorized to apply for a grant as
32 stated above.

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34 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that upon receipt of grant funds, distribution will be at
35 the discretion of the Washington County Emergency Management Coordinator and Public Safety
36 Committee, consistent with the requirements of the grant.

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38 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Board Chairperson and County Clerk
39 are authorized to execute the necessary application or other documents in order to obtain grant
40 funding described herein, subject to review and approval of the County Attorney's Office.
