

**1998 ORDINANCE 19**

**RECODIFICATION OF WASHINGTON COUNTY CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the Washington County Board of Supervisors authorized the preparation of a recodification of the existing Code of Ordinances of Washington County pursuant to §66.035, Wis. Stats.; and

**WHEREAS**, said code described as the Washington County Code has been on file in the Office of the County Clerk for more than two weeks and has been published in book form as directed;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Washington County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the printed recodification of ordinances on file in the Office of the County Clerk and referred to as the Washington County Code is hereby adopted as the code of general ordinances of Washington County.

Section 2. A copy of the code shall remain permanently on file in the Office of the County Clerk.

Section 3. All ordinances or resolutions establishing highway widths not included in said code are not repealed by this ordinance or the Washington County Code and shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. The previous Code of Ordinances readopted by Ordinance No. 25-88-89 on October 31, 1988, be and is hereby superseded.

Section 5. This ordinance and the Washington County Code shall become effective upon passage and publication of this ordinance.
