INFORMATION TO KNOW

- **Previously scheduled school-based clinics have been cancelled**
- Anyone over 6 months of age is eligible for vaccination
- All H1N1 vaccine is free
- Children under 18 **MUST** have a parent or legal guardian sign the Administration Form
- Children under 18 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult (at least 18 years old)
- If you have an egg allergy you are **NOT** able to get the vaccine
- If you have a fever over 100 degrees on the day of the clinic, you are **NOT** able to get the vaccine. You should be fever-free for 24 hours before being vaccinated.
