

Directions to the Washington County Health Department

The Health Department is in the Washington County Public Agency Center, a large orange/tan brick building situated on state highway 33 in the eastern part of the city of West Bend.

From the North (Kewaskum via Hwy 45)

Exit at Hwy 33 (Washington Street) and turn left (east) on Hwy 33. Continue east on 33 through a series of stoplights past the downtown area to the stoplights at Indiana Avenue. The Public Agency Center is located on that corner. From the right lane, turn right (south) on Indiana Avenue and then turn left into the first driveway to access the parking lot.

From the South (Milwaukee or Germantown via Hwy 45)

Exit at Hwy 33 (Washington Street) and turn right (east) on Hwy 33. Continue east on 33 through a series of stoplights past the downtown area to the stoplights at Indiana Avenue. The Public Agency Center is located on that corner. From the right lane, turn right (south) on Indiana Avenue and then turn left into the first driveway to access the parking lot.

From the East (I-43, Saukville or Port Washington via Hwy 33)

Continue west on Highway 33, which becomes Washington Street inside the city. After the airport and a stoplight at River Road you will approach a complex of county buildings. Switch to the left lane, which will become the left turn lane as you approach the stoplights at Indiana Avenue. The Public Agency Center is on the left. Turn left (south) on Indiana Avenue and then turn left into the first driveway to access the parking lot.

From the West (Beaver Dam or Hwy 41 via Hwy 33)

Continue east on Highway 33, which becomes Washington Street inside the city. Continue going straight past the Hwy 45 bridge underpass, through a series of stoplights, past the downtown area, until you reach the stoplights at Indiana Avenue. The Public Agency Center is located on that corner. From the right lane, turn right (south) on Indiana Avenue and then turn left into the first driveway to access the parking lot.

The upper parking lot is for visitor parking and handicapped parking. The lower lot is for employees and visitors who do not need to park close to the building. After you enter from the south (lower level) door, the Health Department is the first door on the left. For immunization clinics and the WIC office, continue to the next set of doors on the left, proceed down the hall, and follow the signs.
