2007 ORDINANCE 37

AN ORDINANCE to create Section 21.09 of the code; relating to: Comprehensive Plan.

The people of the County of Washington, represented in the Board of Supervisors, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 59.69 (2) and (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, Washington County is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in Sections 66.1001 (1) (a) and 66.1001 (2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 2. Washington County has duly noticed a public hearing on the comprehensive plan and a public hearing was held on March 31, 2008, in accordance with §66.1001(4)(d), Wis. Stats.

SECTION 3. The Washington County Board of Supervisors has adopted 2007 Resolution 86, Approving the Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035.


SECTION 4. 21.09 of the Code is created to read:

21.09(CR 07-37) COMPREHENSIVE PLAN. Washington County Board of Supervisors formally adopts the document entitled "SEWRPC Community Assistance Planning Report No. 287, A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Washington County: 2035", as its Comprehensive Plan for Washington County consistent with and addressing the requirements of §66.1001, Wis. Stats.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as provided by law.




