**REFERENDUM**

**State**

Question #1:

**"Elimination of state treasurer.** Shall sections 1 and 3 of article VI and sections 7 and 8 of article X of the constitution be amended, and section 17 of article XIV of the constitution be created, to eliminate the office of state treasurer from the constitution and to replace the state treasurer with the lieutenant governor as a member of the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands?"

**City of West Bend**

Question #1:

Currently, the City of West Bend invests over \$1million (increasing +4% annually) on road and sidewalk maintenance. In addition to this annual investment, would you support the Common Council increasing property taxes by approximately \$640,000, approximately by 23 cents per \$1,000 of assessed value, to apply to borrowing that can be used for roads?

Question #2:

Currently, the City of West Bend invests over \$1million (increasing +4% annually) on road and sidewalk maintenance. In addition to this annual investment, would you support the Common Council increasing property taxes by approximately \$1.2million, approximately by 46 cents per \$1,000 of assessed value, to apply to borrowing that can be used for roads?

Question #3:

Currently, the City of West Bend invests over \$1million (increasing +4% annually) on road and sidewalk maintenance. In addition to this annual investment, would you support the Common Council implementing a \$20 vehicle registration fee (wheel tax) to apply exclusively to road designated borrowing?

Question #4:

Washington County currently imposes a 0.5% sales tax throughout the county and none of these dollars are shared with the local municipalities (e.g. the City of West Bend). Municipalities have recently put forth a proposal to the County for sharing sales tax revenues. Would you support an agreement where the County would distribute up to 25% of the revenues with the municipalities (approximately \$600,000 for West Bend) to apply to road designated borrowing?
