# CTH D Reconstruction

## ***Welcome***

Welcome to the public information meeting for the proposed reconstruction of CTH D from Nenno Road easterly to the Canadian National Railroad.

Your attendance and interest in the project are appreciated. The meeting will be held in an open-house format with a brief presentation at 6:15 pm. This handout and the exhibits on display are available to help familiarize you with the project details. We encourage you to review the exhibits. Representatives from the Washington County Highway Department and Gremmer & Associates, Inc. (design consultant) are here to receive comments and answer questions.

## ***Project information***

The purpose of the project is to reconstruct CTH D due to the deteriorated pavement and substandard horizontal and vertical alignment along the project.

The proposed improvements include realigning the roadway to the north of the existing roadway to increase sight distance along the project. The proposed roadway typical section will consist of two 12-foot travel lanes, and two 8-foot shoulders. Five feet of the shoulder will be paved.

## **There will be no special assessments associated with the project.**

Construction for the project is currently scheduled for 2020.

## ***Traffic during construction***

The section of CTH D being improved will be closed to through traffic during construction. Access to adjacent properties will be maintained throughout much of the project, however there may be brief times during the construction of the project where the residential properties will not have access to their driveways due to culvert placement or driveway construction. The frequency and timing of these access restrictions will be dependent upon the contractor's operations, but they will be for short time durations and the construction inspector will provide advanced notice.

## ***Right-of-way***

Right-of-way (ROW) acquisition and temporary limited easements (TLE) will be necessary throughout the project. Washington County will be working with a separate real estate acquisition company to acquire the right-of-way and easements for the project. The real estate acquisition is scheduled to occur in 2019. If you have land abutting the project limits, you will be contacted separately concerning the real estate acquisition from your property.

## ***Public comments***

We encourage you to talk to the County Highway Department representatives and the design engineers to share your comments, and ask them any questions you may have. A “comment form” is also attached to this handout for your convenience, and may be returned to the registration table or returned by mail as noted on the form. We ask that all comments be returned by Friday, November 9, 2018.
