<b>Ammunition</b> <b>Compressed Gas Cylinders (Propane Tanks)</b> <b>Explosives including Detonators, Blasting caps</b> <b>Infectious, Biological Wastes &amp; Needles (sharps)</b> <b>Latex Paint &amp; Latex Stains</b> <b>Motor Oil (used)</b> <b>Radioactive Chemicals and Devices (ie., Smoke Detectors)</b>

 \*\* Some, but not all, of these products will be accepted. Read labels call for disposal advice.  
 \*\*\* Solvent-products contain words, "Flammable", "Combustible" "Petroleum Distillates".
