NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING

Notice is hereby given that a public informational meeting will be held in Room 1113A of the Public Agency Center in West Bend on Friday, March 16, 2007 at 1:00 P.M. The Land & Water Conservation Division of the Planning & Parks Department will be presenting information pertaining to the Washington County Erosion Control & Stormwater Management - Chapter 17 and new state mandates specifically related to the Department of Natural Resources Chapter NR 151 – Runoff Management requirements. As a result of this meeting an Erosion Control & Stormwater Management (ECSM) Workgroup composed from various municipal representatives and other interested parties may be formed for purposes regarding recommendations to proposed language revisions to the Erosion Control & Stormwater Management – Chapter 17. The Land Conservation Committee will have jurisdiction and preside over the ECSM Workgroup recommendations. No other formal business will be conducted during this meeting.

Individual County Board Supervisors may attend the above meeting. It is possible that such attendance may constitute a meeting of the County Board or any of its committees pursuant to State ex rel. This notice does not authorize attendance at either the above meeting or the Badke meeting, but is given solely to comply with the notice requirements of the open meeting law.
