- 9:00a.m. EWCRC Members and Invited Guests meet at WSOR Horicon Terminal located off State Highway 33 in Horicon, Wisconsin. Please park on north side of the Horicon Depot. (See directions below).
- 9:00a.m. Begin boarding Specialized Inspection Railcar
- 9:15a.m. Inspection Railcar departs from Horicon, Wisconsin, for Germantown, Wisconsin
- 12:00 p.m. Inspection Railcar arrives at Germantown, Wisconsin
- 12:15p.m. Everyone boards motor coach to return to vehicles in Horicon, Wisconsin

DIRECTIONS:

IF COMING FROM U.S. HWY 151 FROM THE WEST, take State Highway 33 east to Horicon, Wisconsin. Follow State Highway 33 until you come to the first set of railroad tracks. Turn left before the tracks and follow gravel road to the Horicon Depot. Please park on north side of the Horicon Depot.

IF COMING FROM U.S. HWY 41 or STH 28 FROM THE EAST, take State Highway 33 west into Horicon, Wisconsin. Follow State Highway 33 until you come to the first set of railroad tracks. Turn right after you cross the railroad tracks and follow gravel road to the Horicon Depot. Please park on north side of Horicon Depot. You will see a sign “Wisconsin & Southern Railroad Horicon Terminal Facilities” located at entrance off State Highway 33.

PURPOSE:
