Motion carried. Mr. Poweleit presented a plan to place between 10 to 15 planters, each approximately 30 inches high and 4 feet in diameter and weighing approximately 2,000 pounds when filled with dirt. Moved by Mr. Schwartz, seconded by Mr. Bausch to use the concrete planters to protect the two wings at the far north and the far south of the building, to be funded from a Homeland Security Grant. Motion carried.

OTHER PROJECT CONCERNS FROM BUILDING COMMITTEE

Judge Resheske stated the County did an excellent job on the planning of the Justice Center. He has no complaints and he is pleased with how the Justice Center is working. He stated that the speaker system is excellent. Judge Resheske stated that the lawyers are very happy with the courtroom environment, as are the jurors. One concern was that more benches are needed on the first floor of the Justice Center. There are currently 11 benches on the premises, but only two of them are on the first floor. There will be a work order to have some benches moved to the first floor, after it is decided where the best place is to locate them.
