Minutes of August 11, 2011

The Washington County Board of Canvassers met Thursday, August 11, 2011, at 9:00 a.m. in the office of the County Clerk, Washington County Courthouse, West Bend, Wisconsin for the purpose of canvassing reported votes at the Special Recall Election held on Tuesday, August 9, 2011.

Present: Brenda J. Jaszewski, County Clerk, Marilyn Merten, representing the Republican Party, and Arlene Beisbier, representing the Democratic Party.

Also Present: Linda Doro, County Clerk Administrative Assistant.

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. and the Affidavit of Posting was read.

The Board examined the ballots. All ballots appeared properly secured in the ballot bags. The following are the findings, by reporting unit, of the Board upon review of the election results:

Write-ins changed from 3 to 0 per Write-In Tally Sheet.

Inspectors' Statement missing total number of ballot bags. Inspectors' Statement indicates five rejected absentee ballots. No reason was given for rejecting the absentee ballots. Bag # 7 was missing the name of the Village, ward number, and election date on the Ballot Container certificate.

Ballot bags #1, #2 and #4 were sealed but due to placing too many ballots in the bags, the openings were accessible. The County Clerk and Deputy County Clerk sealed the bags. Ballot bags # 5 and # 6 were missing the name of the Village, ward number, and election date on the Ballot Container certificate.

Ballot bag # 4 was sealed but due to placing too many ballots in the bag the opening was accessible. The County Clerk and Deputy County Clerk sealed the bag. Ballot bag #4 had seal number D655631 marked on the bag; however, seal number D655651 was listed on the Inspector's Statement. The total number of bags was not listed on the Inspector's Statement. The Chief Inspector did not initial the Inspectors' Statement for the OS and TSX memory card compartment at the closing of polls. The reasons for the rejected absentee ballots need to be more specific. One rejected absentee name was missing on incident log on Inspectors' Statement. The election official's initials were missing on incident log in Inspectors' Statement regarding rejected #4 and #5 ballots. Must hand count ballots to determine actual number of ballots.
