They are reviewed and evaluated against Federal 32 guidelines because part of their funding comes from the USDA and is passed down through the Land 33 Grant College. On a Federal level, there are requirements to meet civil rights laws and guidelines and 34 to make all reasonable efforts to reach a variety of different audiences.
