He reviewed the Historical Society's financial situation in relation to 20 the economic recession and gave an overview of the events that led up to the amount of County 21 assistance that the Finance Committee set for 2010. He discussed several possible options for 22 action on the funding levels for the society in 2010. 23 24 • Do nothing and accept the Finance Committee decision 25 • Recommend a reduction of \$30,000 below the 2009 level of \$175,000 26 • Recommend a reduction of \$15,000 below the 2009 level of \$175,000 27 • Recommend the 2009 level at \$175,000 28 29 Ms. Merten gave an overview on the Historical Society budget and the situation with donations, 30 grants, and volunteers. Mr. Beckford read a letter of support from the director of the Wisconsin 31 Historical Society and commented that many donations were contributed by private individuals to 32 restore the Old Courthouse Building with the understanding that it would be used as a historical 33 museum. Committee members agreed that the Historical Society needs to have a sign of County 34 support. 35 36 Moved by Mr. Healy, seconded by Mr. Heidtke to request the County Board increase the levy by 37 \$65,000 to bring the total Historical Society assistance to \$160,000 for 2010. Motion carried. 38 39 Moved by Mr. Adam, seconded by Mr. Heidtke that, if the County Board supports the higher level 40 of funding for the Historical Society, the Education and Culture Committee would recommend that 41 the County Board, in consultation with the Finance Committee, consider adjusting the General Fund 42
