

## HIGHWAY COMMITTEE

**Vehicle Maintenance and Storage Facility  
West Bend, WI**

**April 12, 2005  
7:30 A.M.**

Present: John Kohl, Maurice Strupp, Mark McCune, and Chairman Tom Sackett. Also present: Commissioner Ken Pesch and Assistant to the Highway Commissioner Barbara Villwock. Dan Goetz was excused.

Chairman Sackett called the meeting to order and read the affidavit of posting.

A motion was made by Mr. Strupp and seconded by Mr. Kohl to approve the minutes of the meeting held on April 5, 2005. Motion carried.

The Committee attended a meeting for all highway department personnel. Issues discussed included changes to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, flagging operations in maintenance and construction zones, winter operations, statewide ROADEO participants, and upcoming projects.

Drainage patterns along the CTH P reconstruction project were discussed with Munzer Haider, Ayres Associates. The sections of CTH P addressed included from CTH PV southerly about 0.5 miles and just north and south of Mile View Road.

A motion was made by Mr. Kohl and seconded by Mr. Strupp to authorize the highway commissioner to apply for Hazard Elimination/Safety (HES) funds for the proposed construction of a roundabout at the intersection of CTH P with CTH PV. Motion carried with Mr. McCune voting no.

A motion was made by Mr. McCune and seconded by Mr. Kohl to authorize the highway commissioner to post an eight-ton load limit on the bridge carry CTH P over Cedar Creek approximately 0.5 miles south of CTH PV for safety reasons. Motion carried with Mr. Strupp voting no.

The committee discussed a request for the inclusion of a bike path along the north side of CTH NN in the CTH NN (CTH P to 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue) reconstruction project. The issue was tabled until a later meeting.

Greg Curtis, Bonestroo, reviewed the results of the East Wet Corridor Decision Matrix. The committee will select a north and south alternate at a future meeting.

A motion was made by Mr. Kohl and seconded by Mr. Strupp to adjourn at 10:50 AM. Motion carried.
