## LAKE DISTRICT'S REQUEST FOR AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES GRANT FUNDING

- 23 Mr. Mueller reported the Green Lake Association has inquired if 2010 Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) 24 Control grant funds would be available to Green Lake for Eurasian Water Milfoil control. Mr. Mueller
