20 Appearance: Betsy Gillen, NRCS District Conservationist

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22 Ms. Gillen stated compliance status reviews would be done on randomly selected tracts, with the field work to  
23 begin the week of June 18, 2007. In addition, CRP status reviews will take place. There are two EQIP no-till  
24 contracts remaining and these are currently being field verified. Work on wetland determination is being done  
25 and Liz Konkel has been hired as an intermittent Soil Conservation Technician.

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29 **NUTRIENT APPLICATION RISK AREAS ON INTERACTIVE WEBSITE**

30 Mr. Sebo gave a demonstration on the county's interactive website and reviewed features available.

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32 **2007 TRANSECT SURVEY UPDATE**

33 Mr. Sebo gave a demonstration on the database for the transect program and stated it takes approximately 2 1/2  
34 days to obtain the data from throughout the county. This data provides valuable information, including soil  
35 loss rates and types and amounts of crops planted within the county. At the next meeting, Mr. Sebo will  
36 present a report from the compiled data.

38 **CONSERVATION CAMP UPDATE**

39 Mr. Sebo stated two applications have been received for the county's \$50 per student grant for the  
40 Conservation Camp that will be held in Marinette County June 21 – 23. Letters were sent to school science  
41 departments with a follow-up phone call to each school.
