

**MINUTES – MEETING 101

The Mortiz-Tobin landmark application was discussed. The wording for the plaque was reviewed and revised. It was shortened and reworted. On a Norbert Dettmann/Beverly Schroeder, the revised working was approved.

The Varga landmark application was discussed. A letter had been received from Jim Draeger of the Wisconsin Historical Society to clarify the wording to be used of the plaque. The wording was shortened. On a Joan Baumgartner/Beverly Schroeder motion, the revised wording was approved.

Brenda Jaszewski will check with Barabara Wenzlaff about the wording before the plaques are ordered.

Discussion was held of the dating of the landmarks. Is it the date the landmark was approved by the commission, or the date the landmarked property is dedicated? This was be clarified at a future meeting.

Because many of the members were absent, the election of officers was not held. On a Joan Baumgartner/Beverly Schroeder motion, it was agreed the elections would be held at a February meeting.
